A programme for young people aged **16-25**, Volunteer 108 encourages you to achieve milestones of **49, 89 and 108 hours** of volunteering. This will be achieved by volunteering at various projects such as our **Soccer Schools, Development Centres, Social Inclusion Programmes and Matchday Experiences**, all of which aim to engage with children & young people.

Volunteer 108 aims to support young people by developing their leadership skills and progressing into employment in a field they enjoy

Yeovil Town Community Sports Trust coaches mentor the volunteers through three levels, which represent Yeovil's giant killing of Sunderland in the FA Cup in 1949, the year the club moved to Huish Park (89/90 season) and the number of years it took for Yeovil to join the English Football League (108).

What you will receive from us:-

STEP ONE – GIANT KILLERS

49 hours of volunteering to mark 1949, the year Yeovil Town famously put Sunderland out of the FA Cup. Volunteers who complete 49 hours will receive emergency first aid training and qualification and safeguarding training and qualification and an introduction to Futsal qualification

STEP TWO - COMING HOME

89 hours of volunteering – to mark the 1989/90 season Yeovil Town left its Huish stadium to relocate to Huish Park. Volunteers who complete 89 hours will be enrolled onto an FA Level One coaching course.

STEP THREE - A DIFFERENT LEAGUE

108 hours of volunteering to mark the number of years from its formation it took Yeovil Town to achieve Football League status. Volunteers who complete 108 hours will be enrolled on an FA Level One Youth Module course.
